The Innovation Award is open exclusively to exhibitors participating in productronica. Entries in the categories Cable, Coils & Hybrids, Future Markets, Inspection & Quality, PCB & EMS, Semiconductors and SMT may be submitted until September 1, 2017. Winners will receive their awards at productronica on November 14, 2017.

Following a successful premiere in 2015 with more than 70 submitted entries, Messe München is partnering with "productronic" magazine to present the productronica Innovation Award again at this year's fair. When the award was first presented two years ago, the following companies were honored:
